











Household Composition



The following categories are based upon self-reported responses The criteria for each category are below:



Chronically Homeless: People who indicated that they have experienced homelessness for at least a year, or repeatedly, while also struggling with a disabling condition.


Mental Illness: People who indicated that mental illness or a mental health condition contributed to their homelessness.

Substance Use Disorder: People who indicated that alcohol or drug use contributed to their homelessness.


HIV/AIDS Positive: People who indicated HIV/AID positive status at any point during the survey. **Survivors of Domestic Abuse:** People who responded "Yes" when asked "Are you homeless right now because you are currently fleeing domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking?"
